Meetings, sharing in worship and hosting presentations. Thank you to all of the individuals and meetings who provided hospitality during these travels!

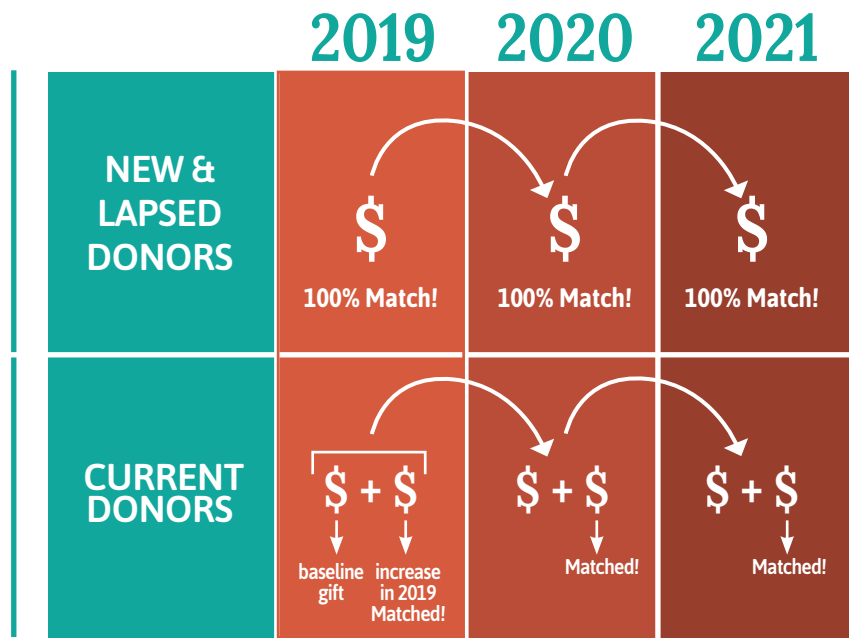
